The conference centre is a **secure premises** and access can only be obtained to the centre by way of electronic pass. If, **in the case of an emergency or unforeseen circumstances**, parents are required to visit a team member - please contact team management.

IMPORTANT: Each team member will be required to bring:

- **Sleeping bag and/or sheets & blankets.**
- **Pillows**
- **Bath towel**

The team will be arriving at the conference centre at approximately 4pm on Friday 9 December. The team will be departing the conference centre prior to competing on the Sunday.

The conference centre is a 'sport & rec. camp' style of accommodation and the sleeping arrangements will be cabin style with approximately 8 team members to a room.

All meals will be provided however if any snacks etc are required it is **essential** that they be purchased prior to leaving on Friday as there are no convenience stores located on or near the conference centre.

Ski's & Boards

Sydney Branch will be towing 2 Board & Ski Trailers to the carnival. Both trailers will be located at Elouera SLSC from 9am on Friday. It is requested that if you require transport for your board and ski that they be delivered and loaded before departure. Each team member will also be required to bring their own 'tie down' straps clearly marked with their name. It is stressed that each team member is responsible for ensuring their equipment is securely strapped to the trailer.

If space is available nipper boards will be transported in the luggage hold of the coach.

Coaches and Team Training

The Head Coach for the Sydney Branch Team is Scott Thomson and he is assisted by Kristie-May Morris, Stephan Strawbridge is beach coach assisted by Ray Masters.

A team training session will be held on Friday at the Red Head SLSC from approximately 2.30. If competitors are arranging their own private transport for their ski & board it is essential that they be available for this training session.

Uniform

On arrival at the conference centre all team members will be provided with a team uniform that must be worn on both days of the carnival. All competitors will be supplied with both a Sydney Branch costume and competition cap. It is the rules of the competition that the team costume must be worn in every event. Paddling tights etc can only be worn if the competitor wears them underneath their team costume.

The carnival is a 2 day carnival to be held at Redhead SLSC situated on the Hunter region of NSW. Day 1 of the competition commences at 10am on Saturday 10 December and Day 2 commences at 9am on Sunday 11 December.

It is emphasised that the Inter - Branch Championships are a unique event in that, for the water events, each individual race also doubles as a team's race. Points will be awarded, on an individual basis, to the first team member of each team to cross the finish line and then both places for each team member are also taken in account to award the teams points.

No medals are awarded for each event however an overall team point score is kept with medals being awarded, at the conclusion of the carnival, to the top 3 Branches.
