All Clubs should familiarise themselves in the conduct of these events. Clubs must be attired correctly as per the competition manual including the wearing of Club caps.

EQUIPMENT

1. Competitors / Clubs will bring their own rescue boards, tubes, first aid kits, Air bag, swim fins, Resus masks and other equipment as required.
2. Garie will provide Manikins, plastic bags, cleaning solution and masks.
3. Garie will provide patients for the first aid competition

PRIZES

- Rescue Boards and other lifesaving equipment prizes
- Points from event placings go towards the competition pointscore for the Branch Championships.

REPORT

Teams and Individuals are to report to the Central Control Tent where marshalling will take place. Report is 8.45 am. Teams and individuals are reminded that as part of some of the events – a ‘competitor lock up’ will be required as party of competition as per the manual. During this time you may NOT be permitted to compete in other events. We will however ensure that the ‘Lock up’ time is as short as possible.
