LOCATION AND ENTRIES

Pending the number of entries received and to avoid lengthy delays on the day, the resuscitation component of the events may be conducted prior to the carnival day at the discretion of the Event Referee. All Clubs should familiarise themselves in the conduct of these events. Clubs must be attired correctly as per the competition manual including the wearing of Club caps.

EQUIPMENT

- Competitors / Clubs will bring their own rescue boards, tubes, first aid kits, Air bag, swim fins, Resus masks and other equipment as required.
- Competitors/Clubs to provide Manikins, plastic bags, cleaning solution and masks.
- Coogee will provide patients for the first aid competition

PRIZES

- Medals will be presented
- Points from event placings go towards the competition pointscore for the Branch Championships
- Rescue Boards and Rescue Tubes

REPORT

Teams and Individuals are to report to the Coogee SLSC Clubhouse where marshalling will take place. Report time for competitors for these events is 7.45 am. Teams and individuals are reminded that as part of some of the events a 'competitor lock down' will be required as part of competition as per the manual. During this time you may NOT be permitted to compete in other events. We will however ensure that the 'lock down' time is as short as possible.
